- Log into your **Applicant Portal** (connect.grad.ucsd.edu/apply):
 - Accept your offer of admission
 - Be sure to fill out the **Statement of Legal Residence form** if it is listed. This form is not required for all programs – if it is not listed, there is no action for you to take on this.
 - Most students are “provisionally admitted” at this time. Please submit the items listed under your “**Pending Admissions Documents**” section in your portal to finalize your admission.
- Please contact GradAdmissions@ucsd.edu if you have questions regarding your pending admissions documents.

Undergraduate Students



- Log into your **Applicant Portal** (beatriton.ucsd.edu/account) and complete your Enrollment Checklist:
 - Accept your offer of admission
 - Complete the [California Residency for Tuition Purposes Questionnaire](#) (if required)
- 2-3 days later, you will receive an email asking you to create your TritonLink Active Directory and Duo accounts.
 - Creation of your Active Directory will provide you with your UC San Diego PID and email.



Step 1: Apply for F-1 or J-1 Certificate of Eligibility

To apply for an F-1 or J-1 visa stamp at a U.S. consulate/embassy, OR to transfer your SEVIS record to UC San Diego (if applicable), you must request that ISEO issue you the appropriate visa status certificate of eligibility document, called the Form I-20 (for F-1 students) or the Form DS-2019 (for J-1 students).

iServices.ucsd.edu will open on **MONDAY, MARCH 3, 2025 (9:00 AM Pacific Standard Time)** for newly admitted Summer 2025 and Fall 2025 international students to begin requesting their immigration documents.

- Update profile and contact information

*Authorization is necessary to view and discuss your student's bill, as educational records are protected under FERPA

Key Take-Aways:

- Contact SFS (undergrad3rdparty@ucsd.edu) at least 6-8 weeks prior to your arrival to set up any third-party agreements
- Ensure that all required documents are submitted promptly
 - Financial Guarantee (based on agency)
 - All third party sponsors are required to provide authorization documentation in order to complete agreement set-up
 - Sign Billing Authorization via DocuSign

7 steps for sponsored student billing at UC San Diego

Sponsored students are those students who are enrolled at UC San Diego, and require UCSD to bill an outside agency (public or private sector sponsor including: military agency, educational institution, and international embassy) for tuition and mandatory fees.

#1 Submit Financial Guarantee

Your sponsor will provide a Financial Guarantee, giving SFS stipulations for the sponsorship coverage.

Must include:
Student's name, PID, coverage duration, specific charges to be covered, and agency contact information.

#2 Complete Billing Authorization

Once your financial guarantee is submitted, you must complete the Direct Billing Authorization form to allow SFS to release and provide information to your sponsor. This form also provides the terms and conditions of third-party billing facilitated by SFS.

#3 Waive Health Insurance

Many sponsors do not cover USHIP- please confirm this with the agency or SFS. If necessary, apply for the health insurance waiver by the published deadline to ensure you are not billed for this fee.

#4 Pay Miscellaneous Fees

Typically, miscellaneous fees (eg. parking, bookstore, etc.) are not covered with one's sponsorship. We suggest checking your account activity when monthly billing statements are released. If there are any open charges on your account not covered by your sponsor, they can be paid online or in-person.

#5 Check Account Holds

Prior to the start of each quarter login to TritonLink and verify there are no holds on your account. Certain holds may block your ability to enroll for future quarters.

#6 Review Account Balance

All tuition and registration fees will be charged to your account, and you will see your sponsorship credit reflected as separate corresponding line items. If there are tuition or registration fees outstanding and your account is current and clear of holds, please contact SFS to inquire further.

#7 Stay Up-to-Date

Please ensure Student Financial Solutions has the most current version of your Financial Guarantee and Direct Billing Authorization. Outdated documents may cause a delay in processing your sponsorship credit.

Please Note:

- All payments must be made in US currency
- All checks should be made out to "UC Regents", and include the student's PID

Scholarships

- **Scholarships should be reported to the Financial Aid & Scholarship Office**
- **Checks should be made payable to: UC Regents**
- **Checks should include the student's name and PID (8-digit number that starts with an "A")**

Note: Checks must be received by the UCSD billing payment deadline – as with all cash payments, the University does not accept the postmarked date as on-time

Direct Deposit

- **Direct deposit is the method for returning excess financial aid and other credits back to the student directly via a bank account, rather than a physical check**
- **Direct deposit means faster refunds and no bank trips! It's the green way to receive your money!**
- **Only a valid U.S. checking or savings account may be used and the account must be in the student's name only**
- **Students can sign up for direct deposit via [TritonLink](#) or the [SFS website](#)**

How to Avoid Housing & Tuition Scams



Protect Your Login Credentials

Never share your online credentials with anyone, nor provide financial information to anyone outside your family.



Use official payment methods.

Only use payment methods approved by UCSD.



Avoid solicitations

Do not respond to 3rd party solicitations for payment of tuition fees.



Beware of WeHousing



Students who use the 3rd party company, WeHousing, to find housing, pay deposits, or pay rent, often receive eviction notices because WeHousing never sent the payments to the owners.

Don't Become a Victim!

If you receive a suspicious call:

1. Hang Up

Tell the caller that you refuse to cooperate with their threats

2. Contact UC San Diego Police

Report the incident to campus calling (858) 534-HELP (4357) and submit a report.

3. Notify ISPO

Inform your international student advisor to identify campus resources for you.

iNewStudents Newsletter

Starting Monday, March 3 at 9AM PT: Request Your Form I-20 or DS-2019 via iServices

International students requiring F-1 or J-1 student visa status to study in the US must request and receive a Form I-20 (F-1) or Form DS-2019 (J-1) from ISEO via **iServices**. iServices is ISEO's document request system. **These forms from UC San Diego are required for all newly admitted F-1 or J-1 students, even if you are transferring from another US school!**

iServices Opens: Monday, March 3 at 9AM PT

iServices will open for newly admitted international students to request their Form I-20 or DS-2019 on March 3. In preparation to submit the request for your Form I-20 or DS-2019, please review the important information below:



- In order to access iServices when it opens, you must have accepted your offer of admission and have **set up** all required UC San Diego student accounts.
- Review the *STEP 1: Apply for your F-1 or J-1 Status* instructions on our **[iNewStudent website](#)** so that you can prepare the required documents and information ahead of time.
