#### Unhealthy


- No communication

- Mistreatment
- Accusing the other of cheating
- Denying their actions are abusive
- Controlling
- Isolating their partner from others

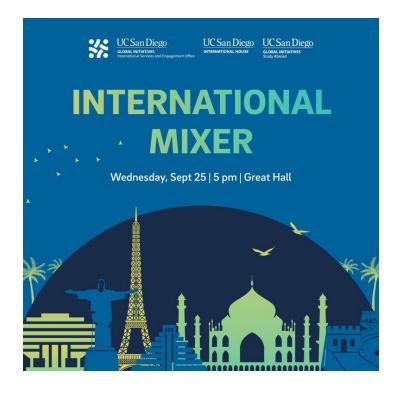








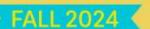
