GET to know each other

- Note: Most CCR-qualifying opportunities require a minimum of 30 hours of participation during one academic year (Fall>Winter>Spring>Summer).
- You can request your Co-Curricular Record (CCR) along with your academic transcript. The CCR can be shared with potential employers and graduate/professional schools to which you are applying.

What is the GET CCR program?



The Globally Engaged Tritons (GET) Co-Curricular Record (CCR) program enables all UC San Diego students to earn credit on their Co-Curricular Record (CCR) for being involved in events on campus that promote the global engagement and internationalization of our university. That could be any event in which students highlight their own culture, learn about other cultures, or develop their international awareness or global leadership skills.



What is the GET CCR?



A skills-based co-curricular student experience combining a wide range of globally oriented activities that contribute to the development of these and other competencies:

- **Understanding Global Context**: Demonstrates an understanding of complex global issues and systems, and how issues and actions have local and global implications for the future.
- Teamwork/Cross-Cultural Collaboration: Works with and seeks involvement from people and entities with diverse experiences towards a common goal, demonstrating strong interpersonal skills, respect, and dignity for others.
- **Self-Reflection**: Assesses, articulates and acknowledges personal skills and abilities, and learns from past experiences and feedback to gain new insights and understandings.

Many GET-CCR-eligible activities are hosted throughout the year by these offices.

Some eligible events may be offered by other university-affiliated departments and organizations.

And **YOU!** Each student makes up an invaluable part of our Globally Engaged Tritons Community here at UC San Diego.

How can I earn GET CCR credit?



To receive validation for your participation in the GET CCR program, you must complete **30 hours of approved activities**. You may mix and match these activities however you choose, as long as you accumulate 30 hours in one academic year (Fall to Summer).*

Some of these activities can include:

- Participating in select intercultural events
- Volunteering at intercultural events
- Requesting funding and running your own event that serves the international students of UC San Diego, or promotes cultural awareness here on campus.

* **NOTE** that any hours accrued during Summer Sessions I or II count towards the **previous** academic year. For instance, if you attended a GET CCR activity or event in July 2024 it would count towards hours earned during the 2023-2024 academic year and **NOT** the 2024-2025 academic year.

Next Steps




Here's how to GET things rolling:

- Make a copy of the **GET CCR Tracker** to record the events you attend AND the hours.
 - Download your copy of the GET CCR Tracker and rename it with your name
 - Copy while logged into your @ucsd.edu account
 - Review the Instructions & FAQ sheets (as tabs) included with the Tracker
- Fill out the <u>Pre-Evaluation Form.</u>
 - That will allow you to count this Orientation for 0.5 hour credit!
- Check out events that quality for GET CCR via <u>iEvents.ucsd.edu</u> (search "GETCCR") and start attending!

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)



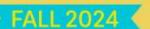
- Is the GET CCR just for international students?
 - No! All UC San Diego international and domestic (American) students can participate in the GET CCR program.
- Is the GET CCR just for undergraduate students?
 - No! Both undergraduate and graduate students at UC San Diego are eligible to participate.
- Can I get credit for something I already attended?
 - Yes! If it was during the current academic year, you can add the event to your GET CCR Tracker.
 Provided your attendance can be confirmed by the event host, it will count toward the 30-hour requirement.
- Can I request that an activity count for CCR credit?
 - Yes! Please complete the <u>GET CCR Petition Request Form</u> for an activity to be considered for GET CCR eligibility. Note that you will need a staff member to validate your participation.
