#### **SERVICES WE PROVIDE TO STUDENTS:**

- ✓ Coordinate Third-Party Sponsorship payments for *undergraduate* and *graduate* students
- ✓ Maintain student billing accounts for all UCSD campus
- ✓ Provide assistance with general billing & payments
- ✓ Issue Triton ID Cards to all students, staff, faculty, and affiliates on UCSD campus
- ✓ Process refunds of credits and overpayments (ie: deposits, e-check, Flywire/Convera/International payments)

#### THIRD-PARTY SPONSORSHIPS

#### **HOW DOES MY SPONSORSHIP WORK?**

- Submit *Financial Guarantee Letter* to Third Party Office as soon it is
- Once tuition & fees are assessed for the quarter, we will credit your account with a 3<sup>rd</sup> party contract to cover your fees
- Student must complete one *Sponsor Direct* Billing Authorization form via DocuSign each year, which is an authorization and agreement to terms of sponsorship
- Any fees which are not covered by your sponsorship (ie: printing fees, bookstore charges) must be paid by the student by the respective billing due date
- If sponsor provides qualifying health insurance, students must waive UC SHIP insurance every year on TritonLink by the deadline
- After the add/drop date of each quarter, our offices will *invoice your* sponsor directly to request payment





#### WAIVE UC SHIP INSURANCE

#### WAIVER MUST BE COMPLETED ON AN ANNUAL BASIS


- Not all Sponsors cover UC SHIP Insurance.
- Complete waiver through TritonLink. This must be completed EVERY academic year.



#### **REVIEW YOUR STUDENT ACCOUNT**

#### BILLING (OTHER THAN TUITION) OCCURS ON A MONTHLY BASIS


- Access your student account via TritonPay
- Tuition is billed quarterly
  - Your Billing Statement isn't always the most up-to-date, so check your account for make sure of the most recent charges.
- Miscellaneous fees are due monthly (ie: printing fees, bookstore charges, sunshine market, etc.)
- If fees are not paid by respective due dates, holds may be applied to your account
- Best Advice: Check your account regularly!



#### **PAY YOUR BILL ONLINE**

#### **HOW TO PAY FEES NOT COVERED BY YOUR SPONSOR**


- Set up a US bank account once you arrive and you can pay online!
- Payments require your routing and checking account number. There is a \$0.50 transaction fee to use e-check.
- Credit cards are accepted (VISA, MasterCard, Discover) and incur a convenience fee.
- Payments made with e-check or credit card are posted to your student account instantly.
- Payments are also accepted at the Cashier's Office in the form of cash or check.



#### **ENROLL IN DIRECT DEPOSIT**

#### "IT JUST MAKES CENTS"

- Direct deposit is the way we return excess financial aid and other credits back to the student.
- Direct deposit means faster refunds and no bank trips! It's the green way to get your money!
- Only a checking or savings account may be used and account must be in the student's name.

#### **KEYS TO SUCCESS**

#### FOLLOW THESE SIMPLE STEPS TO MANAGE YOUR STUDENT ACCOUNT



Make sure your Financial Guarantee is turned in and accepted by SFS, and you received a DocuSign that had you sign a Billing Authorization.

Every quarter, make sure your 3<sup>rd</sup> party contract was credited to your account and that your UC SHIP waiver is reflected (if applicable).





Monitor your student account and be aware of billing due dates to avoid holds which may impact your sponsorship credit from being applied.



#### **SFS Billing Authorization**

#### Privacy Policy

The Federal Family Education Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) (20 U.S.C. § 1232g; 34 CFR Part 99) is a Federal law that protects the privacy of student education records. This law applies to all schools that receive funds under an applicable program of the U.S. Department of Education. Generally, schools must have written permission from the eligible student in order to release any information from a student's education record. By signing below, you are giving the University of California San Diego the authorization to disclose information pertaining to your program/course in order to bill the Third-Party for educational services provided by the University of California San Diego.

By submitting this signed agreement, you acknowledge the following:

- You authorize the University of California San Diego to release information (Name, PID, Grades, Units completed, unofficial transcripts, etc.) to your sponsor as needed to service your student account.
- The above named Sponsor has agreed to pay the University of California San Diego directly. This includes the specified amount of tuition and/or fees charged as set forth in the payment schedule above as well as any future terms to be covered as indicated by the Sponsor. If your Sponsoring agency changes, you must submit a new authorization.
- You will provide all Official Transcripts to your sponsor directly.




