THIRD-PARTY SPONSORSHIPS

HOW DOES MY SPONSORSHIP WORK?

- 1** | Submit ***Financial Guarantee Letter*** to Third Party Office as soon it is available
- 2** | Student must complete one ***Sponsor Direct Billing Authorization*** form via DocuSign each year, which is an authorization and agreement to terms of sponsorship
- 3** | If sponsor provides qualifying health insurance, students must ***waive UC SHIP insurance*** every year on TritonLink by the deadline
- 4** | Once tuition & fees are assessed for the quarter, we will credit your account with a ***3rd party contract*** to ***cover your fees***
- 5** | Any fees which are not covered by your sponsorship (ie: printing fees, bookstore charges) must be paid by the student by the respective billing due date
- 6** | After the add/drop date of each quarter, our offices will ***invoice your sponsor directly*** to request payment

BILLING (OTHER THAN TUITION) OCCURS ON A MONTHLY BASIS

- Access your student account via TritonPay

PAY YOUR BILL ONLINE

HOW TO PAY FEES NOT COVERED BY YOUR SPONSOR

- Set up a US bank account once you arrive and you can pay online!
- Payments require your routing and checking account number. There is a \$0.50 transaction fee to use e-check.
- Credit cards are accepted (VISA, MasterCard, Discover) and incur a convenience fee.
- Payments made with e-check or credit card are posted to your student account instantly.
- Payments are also accepted at the Cashier's Office in the form of cash or check.

Every quarter, make sure your 3rd party contract was credited to your account and that your UC SHIP waiver is reflected (if applicable).

Privacy Policy

The Federal Family Education Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) (20 U.S.C. § 1232g; 34 CFR Part 99) is a Federal law that protects the privacy of student education records. This law applies to all schools that receive funds under an applicable program of the U.S. Department of Education. Generally, schools must have written permission from the eligible student in order to release any information from a student's education record. By signing below, you are giving the University of California San Diego the authorization to disclose information pertaining to your program/course in order to bill the Third-Party for educational services provided by the University of California San Diego.


