Document Self-Check

- Passport
- Visa Page (Inside of Passport)
- Form I-20 or DS-2019
- Form I-94












- **Never Discard Documents:** Keep all copies of your Form I-20/DS-2019 from ISEO and every institution you attend, you never know when you'll need them!
- **Updated:** Keep your documents valid!
- Accessible: Keep digital copies of your Form I-20/DS-2019 and other documents on your phone; keep them accessible and in a safe place.
- **Document Self-Check:** Perform a document self-check each time you prepare for international travel and each time you re-enter the U.S.
