



Barriers to Building Social Confidence



Errors in Anxious Thinking

OVERESTIMATE:

- Probability
- Danger level (catastrophize)
- Consequence
- Others are thinking negative (mind reading)
- How anxious we appear
- Others Confidence

• UNDERESTIMATE:

- Our capabilities
- Our ability to cope
- Others will help us
- Insecurities of others



Barriers: Behavior

- Avoidance
- Escape
- Safety Behaviors



- Personal space




What to Talk About?
