





### How to Submit a Final Transcript

A final transcript is required for any degree(s) earned at institutions within the United States, and in some cases is required for coursework completed at institutions where you did not earn a degree (either domestic or international).

Please have your transcript sent directly to Graduate Admissions using one of the three options below. Transcripts must be the final version, which includes all grades and coursework completed, any degree(s) received, and the date(s) of degree conferral (if applicable).

Option 1: Parchment. Select "University of California San Diego Graduate Admissions" as the recipient in the menu provided by Parchment. This is the best way to ensure your academic materials reach our office and your applicant file in a timely manner.

Option 2: Other e-transcript service/electronic submission of materials. Have your institution send the documents to gradadmissions@ucsd.edu. Please note that you may not email your materials yourself. Documents must be sent by officials from the issuing institution or through a secure, third-party service such as National Student Clearinghouse.

Option 3: Mail. Have your institution send the documents to Graduate Admissions at the address listed below. Please note that we cannot accept documents that were opened or sealed by the student. Documents must be received in an envelope sealed by the issuing institution

This page provides a comprehensive guide for newly admitted international undergraduate and graduate students on obtaining their U.S. student visa (F-1 or J-1) and preparing for their arrival to the United States.

Summer Session Visiting Student: if you will only be enrolling with UC San Diego for Summer Session and will not matriculate into a UC San Diego degree program, please visit ISEO's New Summer Session Visiting Page.

To apply for an F-1 or J-1 visa stamp at a U.S. consulate/embassy, OR to transfer your SEVIS record to UC San Diego (if applicable), you must request that ISEO issue you the appropriate visa status certificate of eligibility document, called the Form I-20 (for F-1 students) or the Form DS-2019 (for J-1 students).

### Step 1: Apply for F-1 or J-1 Certificate of Eligibility





The department from which the student will earn their degree is called the "academic home department," or "home

The home department determines if student is eligible for support

### FELLOWSHIPS






- Intramural vs Extramural
  - Intramural: UC San Diego's funding, like funding from your department, or GEPA Fellowships
  - Extramural: Outside funding
- Many intramural fellowships don't have citizenship requirements
  - Talk to your department coordinator or a professor and ask to see if they know of any fellowships offered by them or GEPA (Graduate Education & Postdoctoral Affairs)
  - Your Graduate Coordinator will have more information about discipline-specific opportunities



# FELLOWSHIP KEY WORDS

- Narrow down your search:
  - Tuition & Fees, Research Abroad, Stipend, Dissertation Funding, etc.
- Key words will help guide your search in the right direction:
  - Pre-doctoral
  - How many more years to completion
  - Advanced to candidacy
  - Dissertation research  $\bullet$
  - Dissertation completion ullet
- Identify the type of award you are looking for:
  - Travel, training, research, general scholarships



### FELLOWSHIP TIPS

- Read the program announcement!
  - The WHOLE thing If you are missing any of the required application materials you should write a statement as to why it cannot be included and when it will be available after the closing of the nomination cycle. All fellowship review requirements are based on each committee's own process requirements. You may find you were not reviewed based on missing/incomplete nomination materials.
- Look for eligibility requirements: •
  - Citizenship, language, certain demographic, institution

### FELLOWSHIP TIPS

- Check all application components:
  - How many people will need to be involved in your application (letters, affiliation, language) tests)?
  - Will you need letters to prove eligibility? Who should sign?
  - Does your application need to be processed by on on-campus office?
  - Authorized Organizational Representative (AOR), business official, institutional approval
  - It's good practice to have the documents listed here in the **Table of Contents Nomination** <u>Packet Sample</u>. The vast majority of extramural fellowships will require these forms and documents. It's best to conserve your time and energy on curtailing your CV and getting specialized letters of recommendation as needed.
  - Remember all nomination packets, accuracy, and completeness are the nominees' responsibility.

### HOW TO RECEIVE FELLOWSHIP STIPEND AND FEE PAYMENTS ON TIME

- Enroll each quarter by the registration fee payment deadline  $\bullet$ 
  - See Enrollment and Registration Calendar
- Be familiar with your stipend schedule  $\bullet$ 
  - If you do not receive your stipend payment by the date posted on the stipend schedule on the Ο Student Financial Solutions (SFS) website, submit a ticket and include your graduate coordinator as a watcher
- Enroll using the <u>Direct Deposit tool</u> via TritonLink
  - Different from Payment Works direct deposit Ο
  - International students who become Resident Alien, Permanent Resident, etc. will have their direct Ο deposit through TritonLink

# ACADEMIC EMPLOYMENT

- Graduate Student Researchers (GSR):
  - Graduate student who performs research as a condition of receiving financial remuneration from funding generated by the University in an academic department or research unit, provided that the graduate student is performing this funded research under the control of the University and under the specific direction of a faculty member or authorized Principal Investigator.
- Academic Student Employees (ASEs):
  Associate Instructors/ Teaching Assistants/ Readers/ Tutors

# Holds


**Holds** are placed on student accounts for outstanding debts

  - Library fines
