





This page provides a comprehensive guide for newly admitted international undergraduate and graduate students on obtaining their U.S. visa (F-1 or J-1) and preparing for their arrival to the United States.

To apply for an F-1 or J-1 visa stamp at a U.S. consulate/embassy, OR to transfer your SEVIS record to UC San Diego (if applicable), you must request that ISEO issue you the appropriate visa status eligibility document, called the Form I-20 (for F-1 students) or the Form DS-2019 (for J-1 students).

- TB Risk Screening Assessment





For AY2025-26, the cost per quarter is approximately \$2,000.00 USD


Students cannot use their home insurance or government coverage at Student Health as we do not hold contracts with other insurance companies!

 Students must be registered in order to access the application. Parents or authorized users are not allowed to access the application.




