



CONGRATULATIONS! Newly Admitted Bachelor's, Master's, and PhD International Students: The International Services and Engagement Office (ISEO) congratulates you on your admission to the University of California, San Diego!

This page provides a comprehensive guide for newly admitted international undergraduate and graduate students on obtaining their U.S. student visa (F-1 or J-1) and preparing for their arrival to the United States.

Summer Session Visiting Student: if you will only be enrolling with UC San Diego for Summer Session and will not matriculate into a UC San Diego degree program, please visit ISEO's New Summer Session Visiting Page.

To apply for an F-1 or J-1 visa stamp at a U.S. consulate/embassy, OR to transfer your SEVIS record to UC San Diego (if applicable), you must request that ISEO issue you the appropriate visa status certificate of eligibility document, called the Form I-20 (for F-1 students) or the Form DS-2019 (for J-1 students).

New Undergraduate and Graduate Degree Students

Step 1: Apply for F-1 or J-1 Certificate of Eligibility

iServices.ucsd.edu will open on MONDAY, MARCH 3, 2025 (9:00 AM Pacific Standard Time) for newly admitted Summer 2025 and Fall 2025 international students to begin requesting their immigration documents.



- Must live on campus admit year: 2025-26
- Must meet all housing and campus deadlines
- Must fulfill full term of contract
- Cancelling or terminating your contract forfeits your guarantee
- Must maintain housing eligibility

HOUSING APPLICATION DEADLINE

- First-Year Students: May 9, 2025
- First-Year Transfers: June 9, 2025

HOUSING CONTRACT PROCESS DEADLINE

- Emails for contract invite will go out the week of June 16th
- First-Year Students and First-Year Transfers: June 30, 2025
- Electronically sign housing contract, submit \$450 housing prepayment and select Dining Plan

Roommate requests* and room type preferences due by July 20, 2025

*Roommates must be registered in same college to request one another.

Optional opportunities to apply for a Living Learning Community or Gender Inclusive Housing: July 2, 2025

Deadline to change your dining plan: October 1, 2025









Housing Assignment, Cost, and Dining Plans

- Incoming First-Year housing assignments begin in the residence halls and apartments in their college of registration, then continue into other oncampus housing areas.
- Incoming Transfer housing assignments will begin in established Upper Division housing neighborhoods (Pepper Canyon East, Rita Atkinson, Pepper Canyon and continue into other on-campus housing areas as needed. Transfer housing assignments may include residence halls.

Students will find out their room assignment in Late August.

Incoming students 2025-26

Residence Halls are typically multi-room suites without a kitchen. Most feature a shared living space and shared bathroom space within the suite. Check the <u>Undergrad Neighborhood page</u> for floor plans and more information.

- Never make any payment without viewing the inside of the property (Virtual/Onsite)
- Avoid trusting FB accounts which are newer and have a history of spamming

- Try to find roommate situations with other students ۲
- Shorter term housing available

Housing Search Tips

- When to Begin?
 - Summer Leases (June): April May
 - Fall Leases (August/September):
 - June July *may request to pay a "holding fee"
- Build Your Needs/Wants:
 - Budget
 - Lease ranges: month to month vs. 6 month vs. year
 - Location
 - Transit Options
 - Roommates?
 - Amenities
 - Laundry?
 - Parking?
 - Utilizes included?
- The Search:
 - Request virtual and/or in-person tours of listings
 - Do not sign lease or pay any deposits before seeing the property
 - Ensure the property aligns with your needs and wants



International Student Housing Tips

Renting with Apartment Complexes

- Longer leases
- Unfurnished, utilities not included
- Renter's insurance required
- ➢ Financial Requirements
 - Higher rent
 - 2-3x proof of income or cosigner
 - Credit score or SSN
 - Application fees
- Separate Services & Precautions
 - SDGE, Wi-Fi, Conservice billed separately
 - Take before/after photos when moving in







Starting Monday, March 3 at 9AM PT: Request Your Form I-20 or DS-2019 via iServices

International students requiring F-1 or J-1 student visa status to study in the US must request and receive a Form I-20 (F-1) or Form DS-2019 (J-1) from ISEO via iServices. iServices is ISEO's document request system. These forms from UC San Diego are required for all newly admitted F-1 or J-1 students, even if you are transferring from another US school!

iServices Opens: Monday, March 3 at 9AM PT

iServices will open for newly admitted international students to request their Form I-20 or DS-2019 on March 3. In preparation to submit the request for your Form I-20 or DS-2019, please review the important information below:



- In order to access iServices when it opens, you must have accepted your offer of admission and have set up all required UC San Diego student accounts.
- Review the STEP 1: Apply for your F-1 or J-1 Status instructions on our iNewStudent website so that you can prepare the required documents and information ahead of time.
- If you are experiencing technical difficulties with iServices, please see review iServices Instructions. If the problem persists, please see iServices Troubleshooting.
