We recognize that individual students may have difficulty entering the U.S. prior to the official start of instruction this upcoming term due to unforeseen travel delays or visa challenges. In acknowledging these possible delays, UC San Diego will allow new students with an initial Form I-20 or Form DS-2019, as well as continuing students with a valid Form I-20 or Form DS-2019, to arrive after their initial session program start date. Students seeking entry after the start of courses are responsible for connecting with their undergraduate college or academic departments to understand the academic implications of late entry.
