SUMMER COOPERATIVE PROGRAM AT UC SAN DIEGO

International students in F-1 status are allowed to be employed in the United States under Curricular Practical Training (CPT) as long as the employment is an integral part of an established curriculum. This Cooperative Education Agreement provides training objectives agreed upon by the employer, UC San Diego Department, and student and facilitates the authorization of CPT for the summer period requested.

Responsibilities of the employer include providing appropriate work and training opportunities, including an evaluation of the work of the student. Responsibilities of the student include adhering to all employer policies and fully participating in the learning objectives. Responsibilities of the department or faculty advisor include providing guidance and instruction as necessary.
