What Is the Purpose of This Form?

Use this form to request an electronic notification (e-Notification) when U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services accepts your immigration application. This service is available for applications filed at a USCIS Lockbox facility.

General Information

Complete the information below and clip this form to the first page of your application package. You will receive one e-mail and/or text message for each form you are filing.

We will send the e-Notification within 24 hours after we accept your application. Domestic customers will receive an e-mail and/or text message; overseas customers will only receive an e-mail. Undeliverable e-Notifications cannot be resent.

The e-mail or text message will display your receipt number and tell you how to get updated case status information. It will not include any personal information. The e-Notification does not grant any type of status or benefit, rather it is provided as a convenience to customers.

USCIS will also mail you a receipt notice (I-797C), which you will receive within 10 days after your application has been accepted; use this notice as proof of your pending application or petition.

□Check for \$410 Fee

Be sure you have enough funds in your account to avoid a bounced check. Bounced checks can result in Rejection or Denial of an OPT Application by USCIS.

- ☐ Fee can be paid by a personal check, money order, or cashier's check.
- ☐ It is okay if the name or address in the top left is not the same as the applicant's information.
- ☐ The check should be made payable to "U.S. Department of Homeland Security."
- ☐ The "memo" or "for" section should state "I-765 OPT
 Application."
- ☐ Write your SEVIS Number anywhere on the front of the check.




□Photocopy of OPT I-20

- Include copies of all three pages.
- Sign and date the original I-20 but mail the copy.
- Check requested OPT start and end dates on page 2 for accuracy.

Remember...

- USCIS **must receive** your OPT Application within 30 days of the Date Issued on page 1 of your OPT I-20.
- USCIS **must receive** your OPT Application within your 5 months window (no earlier than 90 days before your program end date and no later than 60 days after your program end date).




Example of paper I-94 (front and back sides):





- If you have not travelled into the USA since April 2013 OR if you entered at a land border (such as the land port of entry at Tijuana), then you will have a paper I-94 (example to the left).
- if you travelled into the USA after April 2013 and entered by air or sea, you will have an electronic I-94 record (example to the right). You can retrieve your electronic I-94 record here: www.cbp.gov/i94.

Example of electronic I-94:






□2 U.S. Passport Photos

- ☐Photo must be taken within the last 30 days.
- □ Photo must be 2"x2". For exact specifications, visit the <u>U.S.</u>

 <u>Department of State webpage</u>.
- □Lightly print your full name (pen or pencil) AND your SEVIS Number (N000...) on the back of each photo.
- □Photos must be professionally taken.
 - □ UCSD Mail Services has a <u>Passport Acceptance Office</u> that will take passport photos for a fee (no returns).
 - ☐ There are many off-campus locations that offer passport photo services. Please confirm these services follow the U.S. ☐ Department of State regulations.
